Faculty Awards had a productive year. In the fall semester, the committee hosted the dinner for last year's recipient of the Clark Kerr Medal, Nan Keohane, former President, Duke University. We also selected this year's recipient, Professor Karl Pister of our campus.

The committee selected two recipients for the Berkeley Faculty Service Award: Professors Herma Hill Kay and Carol Clover. Both have given extraordinary service to the Campus. It is fortunate that the Chancellor was able to provide funds to maintain the awards at the previous level so as to be compatible with the Campus Teaching Award.

In addition to these specific awards, at the request of the Chancellor, our committee made recommendations for Mellon Emeritus Fellowships (3 nominees) and Heinz Awards (3 nominees).
