

**APPROVED MINUTES
BERKELEY DIVISIONAL COUNCIL
Monday, May 11, 2020 – 12:00-3:00 PM
Videoconference**

Divisional Council (DIVCO) met on Monday, May 11, 2020, by Zoom videoconference due to the COVID-19 pandemic and shelter-in-place. Division Chair Oliver O'Reilly presided. A quorum was recorded as shown on the attached attendance chart. An amended agenda was presented as Handout A. Reordering of the agenda to accommodate the guests for Item V.A. (Task Force on Graduate Diversity report) was approved. By consent, the meeting was extended by 10 minutes.

Senate Nominations for 2020-21

Divisional Council

Appointment of Professor Duncan Callaway (ERG) as a member on the Divisional Council for AY20-21. He is replacing Professor John Ngai.

Committee on Committees

Appointment of Professor Kristie Boering (Chemistry/Earth & Planetary Science) as a member on the Committee on Committees for AY20-21. She is replacing Professor Serena Chen.

Appointment of Professor Debarati Sanyal (French) as a member on the Committee on Committees for AY20-21. She is replacing Professor Ronald Cohen.

The full list of appointments to Senate committee service for 2020-21 was also presented (appended to these minutes as Appendix A).

ACTION: The nominations and full 2020-21 appointment list were approved as presented.

III. ANNOUNCEMENTS

At the last regular meeting of the year, Division Chair O'Reilly expressed his great appreciation for the leadership provided by Divisional Council through several crises this year, and acknowledged the efforts of Division Vice Chair Jennifer Johnson-Hanks this year. Extra DIVCO meetings have been set up during the summer in case additional time is needed.

- Finance reform: Council is awaiting response from the executive vice chancellor and provost to the DIVCO/ CAPRA statement on finance reform approved at the last regular meeting. Although financial issues are managed by the administration, the Senate's expertise and recommendations on issues within its purview deserve to be heard in decision-making.
- Fall 2020 operations: Several committees have been set up to plan for the resumption of fall semester operations; recommendations will be due in mid-June. Council members felt that Senate representation should be robust and committee membership and timelines be made available. Members felt the authority of the Senate in joint administrative/Senate committees needed to be clarified.

ACTION: Division Secretary Keith Gillless was charged to draft a document clarifying the authority of parties in joint administrative/Senate committees; the importance of shared governance will be emphasized. This document will be signed by the Division chair, Division vice chair, and incoming Division vice chair for 2020-21, and distributed to all faculty.

IV. UNFINISHED BUSINESS

A. Electronic Intelligent Systems specialization

Enclosures 5a –5d and materials in the agenda packet for the March 16, 2020 DIVCO meeting.

Since DIVCO's concerns about the proposal were forwarded to the administration, Senate leadership met with Professor Anant Sahai (Electrical Engineering and Computer Science-EECS), and it became evident that DIVCO had not received some supporting documents. After receiving the supporting materials and speaking with Professor Sahai, Senate leadership felt that DIVCO's concerns were resolved, except for one issue regarding undergraduate instructors that is pending arbitration.

ACTION: Divisional Council endorsed the proposal and authorized Division Chair O'Reilly to revise DIVCO's letter to the vice provost for the faculty.

V. NEW BUSINESS

A. Task Force on Graduate Diversity

Enclosures 6a – 6b and Handout B

The task force co-chairs were invited to present their recommendations to Divisional Council, prior to submitting the report to the Chancellor.

Professor Lisa Garcia Bedolla (Education), Vice Provost for Graduate Studies, Dean of the Graduate Division, introduced the task force recommendations, assisted by Professor Jon Wilkening (Mathematics), Luis Tenorio, 2020-21 Graduate Assembly (GA) President, and Larissa Charnsangavej, Director, Student Life. The task force emphasizes accountability, accessibility, and inclusivity, and makes recommendations for outreach and admissions.

Professor Wilkening highlighted the importance of departmental buy-in, as detailed recommendations for improving the departmental admissions process and rubrics were made. Outreach and yield events should be strengthened and engage current students and alumni to a greater degree. Better communication with prospective students and incoming graduate students is also recommended.

Incoming GA President Tenorio reported that better advising, mentoring, and support for basic needs would greatly assist students. The task force also had recommendations on working with students of color, the police, employment procedures, etc.

Good communication is a critical measure across all areas.

Council members were supportive of the recommendations, noting that changes which could be made with little or no new funding should be prioritized. No action was taken on this item.

B. Proposed Revisions to Presidential Policy on Protection of Human Subjects in Research

The Committee on Research supported the proposal. There were no further comments.

ACTION: Divisional Council endorsed the proposal and authorized Division Chair O'Reilly to forward comments to Academic Council.

C. Proposed Revision to Presidential Policy on Travel Regulations

The required use of Connexus for travel was not supported as it is not user-friendly and is too complicated.

ACTION: Divisional Council authorized Division Chair O'Reilly to forward comments to Academic Council.

D. Committee on Faculty Welfare Statement on Health Provisions for Fall 2020

Enclosure 9

The Committee on Faculty Welfare (FWEL) reinforced the fact that many faculty may not feel safe resuming in-person activities in Fall 2020 due to the pandemic, either for personal reasons or because they have close contact with vulnerable family members. This concern is not unique to faculty.

ACTION: Divisional Council approved the statement and authorized Division Chair O'Reilly to inform FWEL.

E. Budget Committee Statement on Conflict of Interest

Handout C

The Committee on Budget and Interdepartmental Relations (BIR) presented a statement in response to the Office of Faculty Equity and Welfare's (OFEW) guidelines on conflicts of interest (COI). The COI guidelines have sometimes created problems in faculty searches, particularly for small departments. Council agreed that the search committee should be allowed to decide who can participate.

ACTION: Divisional Council approved the COI statement.

Council recommended an administrative review of the OFEW be conducted now, at a time when leadership is changing. At the same time there should be an acknowledgement of OFEW's contributions toward a positive campus climate.

ACTION: Divisional Council authorized Division Chair O'Reilly to request to the Chancellor that a joint administrative-Senate task force be created to review the OFEW.

F. Committee on Academic Planning and Resource Allocation (CAPRA) 2020-21 policy and budget recommendations

Handout D

CAPRA Chair Paul Fine summarized CAPRA's policy and budget recommendations for 2020-21, stating that the massive effects of the COVID-19 pandemic make careful documentation of current issues and future concerns critical:

- Finance reform: Post-COVID-19, the financial state of the campus has significantly changed; CAPRA proposes suspension of the current proposal for finance reform and instead, moving toward a new financial process that emphasizes a strong structure of shared governance and collaboration, and impact analysis.
- Administrative unit review: CAPRA feels administrative review would greatly benefit the campus. The first review was positive and clarified not only the unit's issues, but also led to a greater appreciation and understanding of the unit by the campus.
- Academic program reviews: CAPRA wishes to de-emphasize its role in program reviews and focus on the larger financial picture.
- Government relations: CAPRA supports increasing investment in this area, and sees great benefit in the new Faculty Relations Group.

In open discussion a few issues of concern were raised and it was decided to emend the letter, highlighting caution in applying new metrics and shifting funding; some units could be greatly harmed. CAPRA's insights on resources in

academic program reviews are valuable, so continued involvement was encouraged. Closer ties between events and communications staff could improve our effectiveness in communicating about Berkeley. The revised letter will be submitted to a future DIVCO meeting.

G. Diversity Statements in Merit and Promotion Reviews (corrected)

Handout E

The item was initially listed as Diversity Statements in Faculty Searches but was corrected. Postponement of the item to fall semester was suggested to provide more time for thought. It was eventually agreed to begin consideration at this meeting.

BIR Chair Mary Ann Smart noted the committee had been charged by DIVCO last year to develop a rubric for the use of Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion (DEI) statements in merit reviews, as this area is not included in the criteria for review as defined in the Academic Personnel Manual (APM). To make DEI statements mandatory would likely require emendation of the APM. BIR has found that the way in which diversity work is synthesized in merit cases by deans and chairs is critical. Incorporating DEI statements into the standard processes would 'raise consciousness' in faculty activities and would help to better incorporate diversity values within the campus climate.

A broader discussion of diversity was requested, to include those who could be directly affected or who have expertise in diversity. BIR Chair Smart replied that extensive comments had been gathered in the development of the statement. BIR recommends against creating a rubric and presented its current practices within the existing limitations as the best path forward. It was agreed to continue discussion of this topic at the next special DIVCO meeting. No action was taken at this time.

H. Faculty Merits in 2020-21

Handout F

BIR Chair Smart recalled that this statement was prompted by a letter from a faculty member in response to a proposal at the Office of the President to temporarily withhold faculty merits as a way of helping to compensate for increased expenses during the pandemic. The merit-based system at Berkeley is extremely valuable for incentivizing faculty excellence, and in addition, a suspension of merits would unfairly penalize only the faculty eligible for a merit at this time. BIR was firmly against a suspension of faculty merits.

ACTION: Divisional Council unanimously supported the statement and authorized Division Chair O'Reilly to forward the statement to the executive vice chancellor and provost and to the Academic Council chair and vice chair.
